School of Sciences Departmental Fellowships are available to highly capable, intellectually curious students interested in taking a more active role in their educational, personal, and spiritual development while attending Saint Francis University. In addition to the monetary award, fellowship recipients will be afforded the opportunity to gain valuable experience within their prospective field of study. These opportunities include, but are not limited to:

- Involvement in research and hands-on, interactive projects with department faculty
- Presentation of research at regional and national conferences
- Tutoring and mentoring peers within their respective fields
- Active participation and leadership roles in clubs and organizations related to their field of study
- Participation in respective departmental community service efforts

The following information shows the fellowship opportunities within the School of Sciences. Recipients of a fellowship will receive this award for the four undergraduate years that they attend Saint Francis University as long as they continue to meet the requirements set forth by the department.

 - Fellowship Application
 - Performance in on campus or telephone interview
 - Letter(s) of recommendation
