Biography of Tom Peters



Mr. Tom Peters was born in Baltimore, Maryland, then moved to California and resided there from 1965-2000. While in California, he was named one of the “100 most powerful people in Silicon Valley.” He is a civil engineering graduate from Cornell (B.C.E., M.C.E.) and earned an MBA and Ph.D. at Stanford; he holds honorary doctorates from institutions such as the University of San Francisco and the State University of Management in Moscow. Mr. Peters has been honored by dozens of associations in the content areas of management, quality, human resources, customer service, and marketing design. He was enlisted in the U.S. Navy from 1966-1970. During this time he made two tours of Vietnam as a combat engineer. From 1973-1974, he worked as a White House drug-abuse advisor, then went on to working at McKinsey & Co. from 1974-1981. He became partner in 1979, and co-founded McKinsey’s Organization Effectiveness practice. Mr. Peters is widely credited with almost single-handedly “inventing” the public “management guru industry.” He currently presents about 30 seminars each year globally. Since 1978, he’s given well over 2,500 speeches, flown 5,000,000+ miles, spoken before 2,000,000 to 3,000,000 people and presented in 48 states and 67 countries.
